Arts Alive Downtown presents *Temporal City Festival*, a mapped durational, multi-site exhibition utilizing abandoned buildings within a three-block radius of Cathedral Square April 8th, 9th, and 10th.

Temporal City is a festival for time-based and durational media art sited in unused and derelict spaces in the downtown area.

This is a 3-day festival running April 8-10 adjunct to downtown's *Arts Alive* festival. Its focus will be on intersecting downtown geography with unconventional media in support of both artists and community. Ten artists have been invited to execute projects for the duration of the Arts Alive festival. Each work will be site-specific to an unused space within a three block radius of Cathedral Square. These works promise to delight, challenge, and inspire all walks of life!

Viewership will take the form of a scavenger hunt. An artist-designed map of the downtown area will include all work sited in the festival as well as the location of scheduled artist talks and tours. This map will lay out a journey through downtown as you discover sites of creative play. A map may be acquired anytime during the festival from the Arts Alive Information Tent so that patrons may organize their own journey. As well, tours will be scheduled throughout, along with a host of opportunities for public conversation.
